GLOBAL CONNECT SCHOLARSHIP

As part of the Enabling Partnership Scheme, The University of Queensland (UQ) is proud to offer all eligible students from The National Chengchi University (NCCU) the Global Connect Scholarship (GCS) to pursue pathway programs approved by UQ and NCCU.

Scholarship details

A 25 per cent tuition fee reduction is available for eligible students from NCCU who commence an approved pathway program at The University of Queensland for the duration of their studies.

Successful scholarship recipients will also receive a dedicated welcome session and networking sessions each semester, in addition to opportunities to engage with UQ's flagship entrepreneurship programs through UQ Ventures.

Eligibility

To be eligible, NCCU students must:

- · meet UQ program entry requirements
- agree to the Scholarship terms and conditions
- commence studies in UQ's Faculty of Business,
 Economics and Law via an established credit transfer pathway with the NCCU Department of Economics
- · not hold any other UQ scholarship.

All Global Connect Scholarship offers will be subject to the ongoing approval from their relevant host faculty at UQ. Visit **global-engagement.uq.edu.au/gcs-terms-conditions** to read the Scholarship terms and conditions.

If you are not eligible for the Global Connect Scholarship, you may be eligible for other UQ scholarships. Visit **scholarships.uq.edu.au** for more information and eligibility.

Application

All students from NCCU who meet the eligibility requirements will be automatically considered for the Global Connect Scholarship. Eligible students will receive a letter of offer from UQ, with more details about the scholarship and the terms and conditions of the offer
